FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

Hearing Date: May 23, 2011

Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Definitions, Sterilization of Dogs, When License Required, Issuance of Citations and Fines, Criteria to Be Considered, Contested Citations, Citations for Unlicensed Practice

Sections Affected: 2252, 2275, 2284, 2295, 2295.1, 2295.2, 2295.3

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons is included in the file. Office of Administrative Law objected to a definition of "instructor" (f) be included in the proposed regulatory package due current statutory language existing which was different from the proposed language. Therefore, 2252 was amended to delete said definition.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Small Business Impact

This regulatory action does not have any significant adverse economic impact on small businesses.

Consideration of Alternatives
