

**STATE BOARD OF GUIDE DOGS FOR THE BLIND**  
**FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS**

Hearing Date: September 17, 2012

Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Donations, Records, Living Quarters, Attendants

Sections Affected: 2268.2 and 2271

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons (ISR) is included in the file. On page 1 of the ISR, under Problem being addressed, the following statement is made: "Additionally, the Board reviewed their current enforcement authority and identified areas of weakness including the absence of specific inspection requirements of a guide dog school and compliance with the Department of Justice." This statement does not refer to a specific guide dog school, but to guide dog schools in general. In the Proposed Language, 16 CCR § 2268.2, under "Note: Authority cited:," Business and Professions Code section 17510.90 is incorrect; it should be 17510.9. The Order of Adoption reflects the correction.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Small Business Impact

This regulatory action does not have any significant adverse economic impact on small business.

Consideration of Alternatives

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the board would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which it was proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the adopted regulation or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.
